Field conditions have been gradually recovering throughout the week, following the recent rain event.

Weekly throughput was impacted by a scheduled maintenance stop and some unplanned factory stops. During the downtime, crews took the opportunity to undertake additional maintenance activities.

Average weekly CCS was also impacted by the previous week's rain but has shown signs of recovering, increasing from 13.86 units to 14.15 units.

The highest CCS sample was 16.31 units from a rake of Q208 plant in the Up River Productivity District.
