Comments:

A great effort from the milling, growing and harvesting sectors resulted in the best crushing week at Proserpine Mill for the season to date.

The factory processed 93,261 tonnes for the week – nearly 6,500 tonnes above budget.

The harvesting sector had a good week with cane supply, achieving above average bin weights of 9.74 tonnes.

Average weekly CCS rose slightly to 14.26, but continues to track below the pre-season forecast.

The highest CCS sample was 16.27 units from a rake of KQ228 plant in the Elaroo Productivity District.

A scheduled maintenance stop is planned for Wednesday, September 21.

With school holidays in effect, parents and guardians are asked to warn their children of the dangers of playing near cane railway lines.

Our cane trains are in operation around the clock, seven days a week during the crushing season.
