Proserpine Mill achieved good crush rates during the week, with over 15,000 tonnes crushed in a 24-hour period on Tuesday.

A scheduled maintenance day was held during the week, and an unplanned stop was required to do tippler repairs.

The harvesting sector had a good week with cane supply, achieving bin weights above the season average, at 9.82 tonnes.

Average weekly CCS showed improved signs of recovery for the week, rising from 0.44 units to 14.69 units.

The highest CCS sample was 16.60 units from a rake of Q252 plant in the Glen Isla Productivity District.

With school holidays in effect, parents and guardians are asked to warn their children of the dangers of playing near cane railway lines.

Our cane trains are in operation around the clock, seven days a week during the crushing season.
