Comments:

Proserpine Mill's weekly throughput of 77,398 tonnes was below forecast due to falls of up to 32mm in some productivity districts and some steam pressure issues.

About 46% of the weekly throughout was made up of plant cane, with the weekly bin weight average increasing to 9.89 tonnes.

Average weekly CCS improvement slowed again, likely as a result of the wet weather, rising just 0.07 units from the previous week.

The highest CCS sample was 16.60 units from a rake of Q208 ratoon in the Gunyarra Productivity District.

I am also pleased to report that there were no incidents involving the public over the school holiday period. Thank you to the community for doing their part in staying safe around the cane rail network. Please continue to always watch for cane trains, and only cross the cane rail network at designated crossings.

Our cane trains are in operation around the clock, seven days a week during the crushing season.
