Proserpine Mill's weekly throughput of 79,928 tonnes was below forecast due to a scheduled maintenance day and some mechanical issues which are being worked through.

Scattered showers have hung around the districts throughout the week, but have not greatly impacted harvesting operations. Bin weight averages have fallen slightly to 9.80 tonnes, potentially as a result of the wet weather.

Average weekly CCS was below forecast at 14.81 units, but is an improvement on the previous week.

The highest CCS sample was 16.88 units from a rake of Q208 ration in the Gregory Productivity District.

Please continue to use your train brain and remain alert around our cane rail network. Do not linger near any part of the rail network, and only cross the line using designated crossings. Remember our locos are heavy machinery towing heavy loads, and can take a long time to stop.
