Comments:

Proserpine Mill has crushed over one million tonnes of cane for the season to date.

The mill experienced a site-wide blackout and some mechanical issues during the week, which caused the weekly throughput to come in under forecast.

Ongoing light showers throughout the week have not overly impacted harvesting operations, with bin weights holding at approximately 9.8 tonnes.

Average weekly CCS was less than forecasted and had remained relatively unchanged at 14.82 units, likely as a result of the ongoing wet weather.

The highest CCS sample was 16.92 units from a rake of Q208 ration in the Lethebrook Productivity District.

Please continue to use your train brain and remain alert around our cane rail network. Do not linger near any part of the rail network, and only cross the line using designated crossings. Remember our locos are heavy machinery towing heavy loads and can take a long time to stop.

Our cane trains are in operation around the clock, seven days a week during the crushing season.
