Comments:

Proserpine Mill crushed just over 81,000 tonnes this week, with rain conditions and factory reliability improving.

The biggest impact on throughput during the week was a blackout that occurred on Tuesday evening as a result of a cane fire damaging nearby power lines. This caused a prolonged delay in crushing due to the unexpected shutdown damaging equipment.

As field conditions start to recover from the wet weather, the average weekly CCS has increased to 14.16 units, an increase of 0.11 units from the previous week.

The highest CCS sample was 16.58 units from a rake of Q208 ratoon in the Hamilton Plains Productivity District.

Please continue to use your train brain and remain alert around our cane rail network. Do not linger near any part of the rail network, and only cross the line using designated crossings.

Remember our locos are towing heavy loads and can take up to 1km to come to a complete stop.

Our cane trains are in operation around the clock, seven days a week during the crushing season.
