Comments:

Just shy of 89,000 tonnes of cane were processed for the week. This is the highest weekly throughput for the season to date, coming in about 4,600 tonnes above budget. This fantastic result is due to the efforts of all sectors of the industry – from the paddock through to the factory.

Average weekly CCS was 0.01 of a unit under budget at 14.09 CCS. The highest CCS was 16.28 from a rake of ratoon Q208 from the Up River productivity district.

Bin weights have continued to climb, with an impressive 10.06 tonne average bin weight recorded for Saturday, and 9.83 tonne average recorded for the week.

With everyone out and about enjoying the beautiful weather we have been experiencing, we want to remind the public to always give way to cane trains, and only cross the line at designated road crossings.

A fully loaded cane train can take up to 1 kilometre to pull up. Our cane trains work around the clock, seven days a week, so please continue to use your train brain and always take care around the cane rail network.
