Comments:

Proserpine Mill processed 94,508 tonnes of cane for the week, which is the highest factory throughput since 2020. Thanks to all sectors of the industry for working together to achieve this great result.

Bin weights have continued to climb yet again, with an impressive 10.07 tonne average bin weight recorded for Wednesday, and 9.88 tonne average recorded for the week.

Average weekly CCS came in under budget at 14.23 units.

The highest CCS was 16.00 from a rake of ratoon Q208 from the Glen Isla productivity district.

Light showers were predicted for the week, but the industry escaped largely unscathed. There were light showers on Tuesday only, and no impact to harvesting operations.
