#### Comments:

Proserpine Mill processed more than 86,200 tonnes of cane for the week, which was slightly above budget.

There were some light, scattered showers in some harvesting districts, however there was no significant impact to operations.

Average weekly CCS dropped slightly, coming in under budget at 14.64 units. A large proportion of standover was processed last week, which impacted average CCS.

The highest CCS was 17.09 units from a rake of ratoon Q208 in the Lethebrook productivity district.
