#### Comments:

Proserpine Mill processed more than 72,500 tonnes of cane for the week, which was below budget.

A 24-hour scheduled maintenance stop was held on Thursday, with some boiler issues identified and repaired.

The mill has officially passed the 1 million tonne mark, and has processed nearly 61% of the forecast 1.75 million tonne crop.

Up to 27mm of rain was recorded in some harvesting districts, which had some impact on harvesting operations during the week.

Average weekly CCS was 14.78 units which, while under budget, was an increase on the previous week.

The highest CCS was 17.20 units from a rake of ratoon Q208 in the Elaroo productivity district.
