Comments:

Proserpine Mill processed more than 84,400 tonnes of cane for the week, which was slightly below budget.

Following an estimate review, the budget forecast has been revised down by 30,000 tonnes to 1.72M tonnes.

Scattered showers occurred across parts of the Proserpine region. This resulted in excess mud levels in some of the cane supplied, forcing a stop to factory operations to clear chokes.

The average weekly CCS increased by 0.22 units from the previous week, coming in at 15 units – the highest weekly CCS average for the season to date.

The highest CCS was 17.64 units from a rake of plant Q208 from the Elaroo productivity district.

Please remember to use your train brain and always give way to cane trains. A fully loaded cane train can take up to one kilometre to stop.
