Comments:

Proserpine Mill processed more than 89,500 tonnes of cane for the week.

This was nearly 5,000 tonnes above budget, reflecting a fantastic effort from all sectors of the industry.

Bin weights have continued to climb, with an impressive 9.83 tonne bin weight average recorded for the week.

The weather remained clear for the majority of the week, making for good harvesting conditions.

Average weekly CCS continued to increase, coming in above budget at 15.28 units – the highest weekly CCS average for the season to date.

The highest CCS was 17.75 units from a rake of ratoon Q183 from the Lethebrook productivity district.

This is the first week over the 11 production weeks that a variety other than Q208 has topped the charts.
