Comments:

Proserpine Mill processed over 83,600 tonnes of cane for the week, coming in just over budget.

Average weekly CCS increased slightly to come in above budget at 15.51 units – the highest weekly CCS average for the season to date.

The highest CCS recorded was an impressive 18.10 units from a rake of plant Q208 from the Kelsey Creek productivity district.

As a result of the dry conditions and local fire ban, the business has strengthened its fire-prevention and containment measures.

The first cessation of crushing notice has been issued to growers. Based on an expected final crop of 1.72 million tonnes, no further rain disruptions and forecast factory throughputs, harvesting is currently expected to finish on Sunday 3 December 2023.
