#### Comments:

Proserpine Mill processed more than 58,400 tonnes of cane for the week.

This was below budget due to an extended maintenance stop to reinstate the No.5 mill.

Light showers of up to 12mm were recorded across the region, but there was minimal impact to harvesting operations.

Average weekly CCS continued to climb, averaging 15.52 units for the week.

The highest CCS recorded was 17.97 units from a rake of ratoon Q183 from the Lethebrook productivity district.

A reminder that our cane trains operate 24/7. Please only cross cane rail lines at designated crossings and always look for cane trains before proceeding.

Remember to use your train brain and always give way to cane trains. A fully loaded cane train can take up to one kilometre to stop.
