Comments:

Proserpine Mill processed more than 57,100 tonnes of cane for the week.

This was below budget due to an extended stop to repair the sugar dryer motor, followed by a factory blackout caused by an external power outage.

Based on an expected final crop estimate of 1.70 million tonnes, planned factory throughputs and no further rain disruptions, harvesting is currently expected to finish on Thursday, 7 December 2023.

Average weekly CCS dropped slightly from the previous week, but remains high at 15.45 units. This is more than a unit above the season-to-date CCS.

The highest CCS recorded was 18.00 units from a rake of ratoon Q183 from the Elaroo productivity district.

A reminder that our cane trains operate 24/7. Please only cross cane rail lines at designated crossings and always look for cane trains before proceeding.

Remember to use your train brain and always give way to cane trains. A fully loaded cane train can take up to one kilometre to stop.
