Comments:

Proserpine Mill processed more than 72,400 tonnes of cane for the week. This was the last cane processed for the 2023 season.

There was an unplanned maintenance stop early in the week to complete repairs to the chain on the bagasse reclaimer, and to allow molasses levels to drop.

The last cane was crushed at 4.24pm on Saturday 9 December.

Proserpine Mill processed just over 1.7 million tonnes of cane for the 2023 season. The provisional season CCS was 14.52 units, which is 0.39 of a unit above the original forecast.

The highest CCS recorded for the week was 17.62 units from a rake of ratoon Q208 harvested in the Cannon Valley productivity district.

I would like to acknowledge all of Wilmar's Proserpine employees for their hard work in processing this year's crop.

On behalf of the team at Wilmar Sugar and Renewables, thank you for your cooperation during the 2023 season.

Although the production season has ended, locomotive movements will continue over the next few weeks as we carry out bin maintenance.

Please continue to use your train brain and approach all cane crossings with caution.
