Proserpine Mill's 2024 production season commenced just after 7.08pm on Tuesday 25 June.

The factory experienced some start-up issues in the early part of the week, and widespread rain ceased all harvesting operations mid-week. As a result, only 4,027 tonnes of cane were able to be processed for the week.

Average weekly CCS came in above budget, sitting at 12.24.

The highest CCS sample for the week was 14.07 from a rake of plant Q247 in the Hamilton Plains productivity district.

As always, please remember to use your train brain and take care around our cane rail network. Our cane trains are working around the clock, seven days a week.

We also ask parents and guardians to remind their children about the dangers of playing on or near the cane rail network during the school holidays.
