Comments

Crushing operations were severely impacted by a rain event that halted cane supply from Monday through until Saturday.

Throughput was well below budget as a result. Harvesting operations resumed on Friday, with the mill restarting production on Saturday.

Average weekly CCS came in below budget at 13.40 units.

The highest CCS was 15.64 units from a rake of first ratoon Q240 from the Lethebrook productivity district.

Following a shutdown for wet weather last week we have resumed normal operations on our cane rail network. Our cane trains work around the clock, seven days a week

Please only cross cane rail lines at designated crossings and always look for cane trains before proceeding.
