Comments

The week's crushing operations were severely affected by a rain event that halted cane supply from Monday through until Wednesday. Throughput was well below budget as a result, with just over 46,000 tonnes processed.

Harvesting operations resumed on Wednesday, with the mill restarting production on Thursday.

The average weekly CCS came in slightly below budget at 14.54 units.

The highest CCS was 16.36 units from a rake of ratoon SRA 9 from the Lethebrook productivity district.

Please remember to use your train brain and always take care around our cane rail network. A fully loaded cane train can take up to one kilometre to pull up. Our cane trains work around the clock, seven days a week.
