#### Comments

Proserpine Mill processed almost 86,800 tonnes of cane for the week, bringing the season total to 1.44M tonnes – which represents 83 per cent of the total forecast crop

Throughput was again above budget in a week where a scheduled maintenance stop was also undertaken.

The average weekly CCS came in below budget at 13.80 units.

The highest CCS was 17.18 units from a rake of ratoon Q183 from the Lethebrook productivity district.

Recently our locos have reported several close calls with vehicles around our track. Please remember to use your train brain and always take care around our cane rail network.

A fully loaded cane train can take up to one kilometre to pull up. Our cane trains work around the clock, seven days a week
