Comments

Proserpine Mill processed just over 77,000 tonnes of cane for the week. This brought the season total to 1.52M tonnes, which represents 88 per cent of the total forecast crop

Throughput was below budget due to the impact of a mid-week rain event on field conditions.

I would like to thank the harvesting sector for working through some extremely challenging conditions in the latter part of the week, in order to keep cane supply up to the factory.

Average weekly CCS came in below budget at 13.38 units.

The highest CCS was 16.61 units from a rake of ratoon Q208 from the Lower Gregory productivity district.

Please only cross cane rail lines at designated crossings and always look for cane trains before proceeding.

Our cane trains work around the clock, seven days a week. Please continue to use your train brain and always take care around the cane rail network.
