#### Comments

Crushing operations were interrupted by a rain event late in the week which halted cane supply over the weekend. As a result, the total weekly throughput of just over 74,000 tonnes was below budget.

Harvesting operations are expected to resume later this week.

We have now processed more than 1.59M tonnes season to date, which represents 92 per cent of the total forecast crop.

Average weekly CCS came in below budget at 13.38 units.

The highest CCS was 15.78 units from a rake of plant Q240 from the Kelsey Creek productivity district.

Residents are reminded that loco movements continue even during wet weather shut down periods, so please continue to take care at cane rail crossings and ensure that children stay well away from the cane rail network.

As always, please remember to use your train brain and take care around our cane rail network. Our cane trains are working around the clock, seven days a week.
