#### Comments

Crushing operations for the week were severely affected by a rain event that halted cane supply from Sunday through until the middle of last week.

Harvesting operations resumed on Wednesday, with the mill restarting production on Thursday. As a result, the total weekly throughput of just over 29,300 tonnes was well below budget.

We have now processed more than 1.62M tonnes of cane, season to date, which represents 94 per cent of the total forecast crop.

Average weekly CCS levels were disappointing and came in below budget at 11.44 units.

The highest CCS was 14.11 units from a rake of ratoon Q183 from the Conway productivity district.

The rain event has also caused a revision to end of season plans. We now expect harvesting to finish on Wednesday, 18 December.

With school holidays under way, we ask parents and carers to remind children about the dangers of playing on or around cane rail lines.

Our cane trains work around the clock, seven days a week, so please continue to use your train brain and always take care around the cane rail network.
