Comments

Crushing operations for last week were again severely impacted by a rain event that halted cane supply from Thursday onwards.

As a result, the total weekly throughput of just over 50,000 tonnes of cane was well below budget.

Average weekly CCS levels were disappointing and came in below budget at 11.80 units.

The highest CCS was 14.47 units from a rake of ratoon Q183 from the Elaroo productivity district.

Widespread rain and thunderstorms early this week has meant we are unable to restart the factory due to ongoing lack of cane supply. Consequently, the decision has been made to end the 2024 season.

In total the factory processed more than 1.67M tonnes of cane, for the season, which represents almost 97 per cent of the total forecast crop.

With school holidays in progress, we ask parents and carers to remind children about the dangers of playing on or around cane rail lines.

Our cane trains will continue to operate on the rail network for the next few days, so please continue to take care around the cane rail network.
