Comments

After experiencing delays due to mechanical issues and wet weather leading up to the start of Proserpine Mill's 2025 production season, operations commenced on Sunday, 22 June.

The factory experienced some start-up issues in the early part of the week but had settled down by mid-week. As a result, a total of just over 61,000 tonnes of cane was processed for the week.

Average weekly CCS came in above budget, at 12.80 units.

The highest CCS sample for the week was 15.40 from a rake of ratoon KQ228 in the Gonyarra productivity district.

Now that the school holidays have commenced, we ask parents and guardians to remind their children about the dangers of playing on or near the cane rail network.

As always, please remember to use your train brain and take care around our cane rail network. Our cane trains are working around the clock, seven days a week.
