#### Comments

Proserpine Mill resumed factory operations on Thursday 3 July after a wet weather stop early in the week. As a result, just under 50,000 tonnes of cane were processed for the week.

Factory operations have performed well since the restart.

The average weekly CCS came in above budget, at 13.07.

The highest CCS sample of 15.79 units was from a rake of KQ228 ratoon in the Lethebrook productivity district.

With school holidays in their final week, we again would like to ask all parents and caregivers to remind their children about the dangers of playing on or near the cane rail network.

Please only cross cane rail lines at designated crossings and always look for cane trains before proceeding.

Remember that a fully loaded cane train can take up to 1km to pull up.
