Showers early in the week impacted harvesting and cane supply to the factory. As a result, the weekly throughput was restricted to just under 68,500 tonnes of cane.

Thanks to all harvesting contractors for putting in such a tremendous effort to supply cane in wet and difficult field conditions.

The average weekly CCS came in above budget, at 13.18.

The highest CCS sample of 15.70 units was from a rake of KQ228 ratoon in the Lethebrook productivity district.
