Comments

Proserpine Mill performed well last week and processed just under 88,500 tonnes of cane – the highest weekly throughput for the 2025 season to date.

The average weekly CCS came in slightly above budget, at 13.13 units.

The highest CCS sample of 16.10 units was from a rake of Q183 plant in the Lethebrook productivity district.

A scheduled maintenance stop is planned for Wednesday, 30 July.

Our cane trains work around the clock, seven days a week, so please continue to use your train brain and always take care around the cane rail network. A fully loaded cane train can take up to one kilometre to pull up.
