Comments

Proserpine Mill processed just over 80,000 tonnes for the week.

Throughput was slightly below budget mainly due to an extended stop to clear a bagasse belt choke.

The crop is currently cutting at 102% season to date when compared to the original estimate.

Average weekly CCS came in above budget, at 13.73 units.

The highest CCS sample of 16.49 units was from a rake of Q183 plant in the Lethebrook productivity district.

We want to remind the public to always give way to cane trains, and only cross the line at designated road crossings.

Remember that a fully loaded cane train can take up to one kilometre to pull up. Our cane trains work around the clock, seven days a week, so please continue to use your train brain and always take care around the cane rail network.
