Comments

Proserpine Mill processed just under 80,000 tonnes for the week, pushing the season total past the half-million tonnes mark.

Throughput was below budget, mainly due to a scheduled maintenance stop during the week.

Cane quality has been good overall, however, there have been a few rakes of low-quality cane delivered recently that have caused processing issues in the factory. Please advise our logistics staff if you suspect any cane quality issues that could impact factory operations.

Average weekly CCS came in above budget, at 13.72 units.

The highest CCS sample of 16.74 units was from a rake of Q183 plant in the Elaroo productivity district.

Please only cross cane rail lines at designated crossings and always look for cane trains before proceeding.

Our cane trains work around the clock, seven days a week, so please continue to use your train brain and always take care around the cane rail network.
