#### Comments

Proserpine Mill processed just over 85,600 tonnes for the week, which was above budget in a week that included a planned stop to carry out roller arcing in the factory.

Average bin weights rose slightly to 9.53 tonnes for the week.

Average weekly CCS came in a half a unit above budget, at 14.72 units.

The persistent dry weather has created favourable harvesting conditions, however the estimate has declined slightly and is cutting at 99.8% season to date when compared to the original estimate.

The highest CCS sample of 17.37 units was from a rake of Q183 plant cane in the Lethebrook productivity district.

We want to remind the public to always give way to cane trains and only cross the line at designated road crossings.

Remember that a fully loaded cane train can take up to one kilometre to pull up. Our cane trains work around the clock, seven days a week, so please continue to use your train brain and always take care around the cane rail network.
