Comments

Proserpine Mill processed just under 84,000 tonnes for the week, which was above budget, and the result of another solid week of factory performance.

Proserpine Mill has now processed more than 1.1M tonnes of cane season to date.

Average weekly CCS came in more than half a unit above budget, at 15.30 units.

The highest CCS sample of 18.28 units was from a rake of Q208 ratoon cane in the Lethebrook productivity district.

With the school holidays entering their final week, we again ask parents and guardians to remind their children about the dangers of playing on or near the cane rail network.

We want to remind the public to always give way to cane trains and only cross the line at designated road crossings.

Remember that a fully loaded cane train can take up to one kilometre to pull up. Our cane trains work around the clock, seven days a week, so please continue to use your train brain and always take care around the cane rail network.
