#### Comments

Proserpine Mill processed just under 80,000 tonnes for the week.

This was below budget in a week that included a planned roller arcing stop and several unplanned stops as a result of poor quality cane.

Proserpine Mill has now processed just under 1.19M tonnes of cane season to date.

Average weekly CCS came in more than half a unit above budget, at 15.29 units.

The highest CCS sample of 17.92 units was from a rake of Q208 ratoon cane in the Lethebrook productivity district.

Based on an expected final crush of 1.53 million tonnes, forecast factory throughputs and no further rain disruptions, harvesting in the Proserpine Mill area is currently expected to finish on Sunday, 2 November 2025.

Dry conditions are impacting the remaining crop and we are seeing a further reduction in yield.

With school holidays ending across Queensland, we want to thank all parents and guardians for keeping their children safe and away from our cane rail network.

Please remember to use your train brain and always take care around the cane rail network. Our cane trains work around the clock, seven days a week.
