Comments

Proserpine Mill processed just over 79,000 tonnes for the week.

This was below budget in a week that included several unplanned stops because of poor-quality cane.

Proserpine Mill has now processed just under 1.27M tonnes of cane season to date.

Continuing dry conditions are impacting the remaining crop and we are seeing an ongoing reduction in yield. Bin weights are also trending down with last week's average coming in at 9.17 tonnes.

Average weekly CCS came above budget, at 15.22 units.

The highest CCS sample of 17.78 units was from a rake of Q208 ratoon cane in the Up River productivity district.

Based on an expected final crush of 1.52 million tonnes, forecast factory throughputs and no further rain disruptions, harvesting in the Proserpine Mill area is currently expected to finish on Saturday, 1 November 2025.

We want to remind the public to always give way to cane trains and only cross the line at designated road crossings.

Remember that a fully loaded cane train can take up to one kilometre to pull up. Our cane trains work around the clock, seven days a week, so please continue to use your train brain and always take care around the cane rail network.
