#### Comments

Proserpine Mill processed just over 86,300 tonnes for the week, which was above budget, and the result of a solid week of strong factory performance.

Thanks also to the harvesting contractors and growers for their efforts in the field that assisted in achieving this throughput.

Proserpine Mill has now processed just over 1.35M tonnes of cane season to date.

Average weekly CCS came above budget, at 15.34 units.

The highest CCS sample of 18.15 units was from a rake of Q183 ratoon cane in the Kelsey Creek productivity district.

Continuing dry conditions are impacting the remaining crop and we are seeing an ongoing reduction in yield.

Based on an expected final crush of 1.50 million tonnes, forecast factory throughputs and no further rain disruptions, harvesting in the Proserpine Mill area is currently expected to finish on Thursday, 30 October 2025.

Please remember to cross cane rail lines at designated crossings only and always check for cane trains before proceeding.

Our cane trains work around the clock, seven days a week, so please use your train brain and always take care around the cane rail network.
