Comments

Proserpine Mill processed just over 59,000 tonnes for the week, which was below budget. This was due mainly to a 47-hour unplanned stop early in the week to repair tube leaks in Boiler 4.

Proserpine Mill has now processed just over 1.41M tonnes of cane season to date.

Average weekly CCS came in above budget, at 15.40 units.

The highest CCS sample of 17.91 units was from a rake of KQ228 ratoon cane in the Lethebrook productivity district.

Based on an expected final crush of 1.49 million tonnes, forecast factory throughputs and no further rain disruptions, harvesting in the Proserpine Mill area is currently expected to finish on or around **Friday, 31 October 2025**.

We want to remind the public to always give way to cane trains and only cross the line at designated road crossings.

Remember that a fully loaded cane train can take up to one kilometre to pull up. Our cane trains work around the clock, seven days a week, so please continue to use your train brain and always take care around the cane rail network.
