Comments

Proserpine Mill's 2026 production season commenced mid-morning on Wednesday 10 June – a day later than planned due to mechanical issues.

Further mechanical issues following start-up resulted in intermittent stops until Friday afternoon by which time the factory had settled in well.

Proserpine Mill has processed just over 22,000 tonnes of cane for the season to date.

Average weekly CCS came in above budget, at 13.41 units.

The highest CCS sample for the week of 15.13 units was from a rake of Q228 ratoon cane in the Gunyarra productivity district.

The sugar production season is now in full swing and our cane trains are operating 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

Motorists are reminded to look out for cane trains and only cross cane rail lines at designated crossings.
