Comments

Proserpine Mill processed just over 40,000 tonnes of cane for the week, bringing the season total to 133,149 tonnes.

The reduced throughput was due to an extended stop caused by the derailment of an external sugar train at the Port of Mackay. The incident forced a stop to sugar production, as we were unable to clear the onsite sugar bin.

Reduced harvesting recommenced on Wednesday and the factory returned to full production on around 2pm Thursday.

Average weekly CCS came in above budget, at 13.43 units.

The highest CCS sample for the week was 15.95 units, from a rake of Q253 plant cane in the Lethebrook productivity district.

Now that the school holidays have commenced, we again ask parents and guardians to remind their children about the dangers of playing on or near the cane rail network

Please only cross cane rail lines at designated crossings and always look out for cane trains before proceeding.

Our cane trains work around the clock, seven days a week, so remember to use your train brain.
