Comments

Proserpine Mill processed just over 77,000 tonnes of cane for the week. Throughput was above budget and brought the season total to almost 210,500 tonnes.

Wet paddock conditions in some areas impacted factory operations during the week. We acknowledge the efforts made by our contractors to minimise dirt levels in bins.

Average weekly CCS came in above budget, at 13.68 units.

The highest CCS sample for the week was 15.97 units, from a rake of KQ228 plant cane in the Lethebrook productivity district.

With school holidays in their second week, we again would like to ask all parents and guardians to remind their children about the dangers of playing on or near the cane rail network.

Our cane trains work around the clock, seven days a week, so please continue to use your train brain and always take care around the cane rail network. A fully loaded cane train can take up to one kilometre to pull up.
