Comments:

Proserpine Mill's throughput was restricted to 75,771 tonnes, just below budget, due to rain in the latter part of the week.

Falls of up to 40mm disrupted harvesting operations and caused a reduction in cane supply from Thursday through to Saturday.

Regular surveys of harvest operators were conducted to establish the impact on field conditions and to maximise daily cane supply.

The highest CCS sample was 14.65 from a rake of first ratoon KQ228 in the Kelsey Creek Productivity District
