Fine weather early in the week supported harvesting operations and saw contractors settle into a routine.

Unfortunately wet weather put the brakes on harvesting later in the week, and crushing stopped on Friday evening due to cane supply issues.

This resulted in Proserpine Mill's weekly throughput being reduced to less than 72,000 tonnes.

The wet weather stop was used as an opportunity to perform factory maintenance.

The highest CCS sample was 16.06 from a rake of plant Q240 in the Elaroo Productivity District.
