Proserpine Mill crushed 98,350 tonnes of cane for the week – the best weekly throughput this season. The 500,000 tonnes milestone was reached late on Thursday evening.

Dry weather this week has allowed field conditions to improve considerably for harvesting operations.

Average weekly CCS eclipsed 14 units for the first time this season.

There was an unscheduled stop late on Tuesday evening to carry out necessary repairs to the No. 1 mill intermediate carrier.

The highest CCS sample was 16.47 from a rake of first ratoon Q208 in the Elaroo Productivity District.
