#### Comments:

Proserpine Mill processed close to 83,000 tonnes of cane for the week – a good throughput given there was a scheduled cleaning and maintenance stop on Wednesday.

There were some scattered showers during the week, but no negative impact to harvesting operations.

The rain also had little effect on CCS, which climbed to an average of 14.54 for the week.

The highest CCS sample was 17.16 from a rake of first ratoon Q183 in the Elaroo Productivity District.
