Proserpine Mill processed close to 91,000 tonnes of cane for the week – a good throughput given there were some unscheduled stops for necessary repairs.

Scattered showers persisted again, but there was no impact on harvesting operations.

CCS climbed steadily to an average of 14.65 units for the week.

The highest CCS sample was 17.21 from a rake of first ratoon Q240 in the Gunyarra Productivity District.

On Wednesday this week, there will be an eight-hour scheduled mill stop to allow for mill roller arcing and pressure cleaning of a boiler induced draft fan.
