Proserpine Mill processed more than 94,000 tonnes of cane for the week – another good weekly throughput.

The one million tonnes crushed milestone was reached on Monday evening.

Harvesting conditions remain favourable and the crop is averaging just above 99% of original estimate, season to date.

Average weekly CCS jumped back up, reaching the highest level for the season at 14.99 units.

The highest CCS sample was 17.61 from a rake of fourth ratoon Q183 in the Lethebrook Productivity District.

Thanks to parents, carers and their children for an incident-free school holiday period. However please remember that the dangers of playing on or near our cane rail network remain while the season continues.

We urge the travelling public to 'Use your train brain' and always giving way to cane trains.
