Comments:

Proserpine Mill's 2021 crushing season commenced just after 10am on Thursday, 1 July.

Throughput for the first week was 12,262 tonnes, which was below budget. This was predominantly as a result of some initial equipment start-up commissioning.

Wet weather conditions through the week didn't adversely interrupt harvesting and the CCS results have commenced above budget, at 12.85.

The highest CCS sample was 14.88 from a rake of plant Q208 in the Glen Isla Productivity District.

Road users in the district would have noticed Wilmar's cane train safety billboards on the Bruce Highway, north and south of Proserpine. Our key message to all is: 'Use your train brain'. Please be cane train smart around our rail network.

We also ask parents and guardians to remind their children about the dangers of playing on or near the cane rail network during the school holidays.
