Comments:

Throughput for the week was above budget, with 88,633 tonnes of sugarcane crushed.

Field conditions have been favourable for harvesting contractors to deliver a good supply of cane. Both the harvesting sector and factory are settling into a regular rhythm.

Average weekly CCS was 13.66 – more than half a unit above budget.

The highest CCS sample was 16.1 from a rake of plant Q240 in the Waterson Productivity District.
