Comments:

Throughput for the week was above budget, with more than 87,000 tonnes of sugarcane crushed.

Our first scheduled major maintenance day is on Wednesday 28 July.

Field conditions continue to be favourable for harvesting with good cane supply to the factory.

Average weekly CCS jumped to 13.85 – maintaining more than half a unit above budget.

The highest CCS sample was 16.33 from a rake of first ratoon KQ228 in the Kelsey Creek Productivity District.
