Throughput for the week was above budget, with more than 81,000 tonnes of sugarcane crushed.

The scheduled maintenance day on Wednesday 28 July was successful, with planned works completed.

Both the harvesting and milling sectors have performed well over the past three weeks, with above-budget outputs.

Average weekly CCS jumped to 14.38 – almost a full unit above budget.

The highest CCS sample was 16.80 from a rake of first ratoon KQ228 in the Lethebrook Productivity District.
